### **NDI PEER MENTOR PROGRAM**

Peer Mentors are a group of undergraduate students at Notre Dame who serve as a resource and point of contact for new visiting international students. They guide and mentor the exchange students throughout their semester abroad at ND by meeting with them regularly to check how they are adjusting, taking them to campus events, and connecting them to various resources.
